LIBRARY ARRANGEMENTS

The Library is stored with the undersigned at 518/520 Halifax Road, BRADFORD, West Yorkshire BD6 2LP, and books should be requested by post; it will be appreciated if telephone (01274-601268) is used only where absolutely necessary; however, a fax may be sent to the same number at any time. Where possible, books will be brought by arrangement to a convenient meeting place (eg. Society meetings, though with my removal to Bradford, this may be less possible than previously) or will be sent by post (second-class, unless otherwise requested). Post and other relevant expenses are paid by the borrower, and should be refunded direct to the Librarian (to his account, not the Society's; stamps are OK) when returning the book(s). Any reasonable number of books may be borrowed at any one time; where possible, borrowers will be advised if books are not available for any reason, such as being with another borrower.

The normal period of loan is 1 month, but books may be retained (or requested in advance) for longer periods by arrangement when no other member is waiting to borrow them. The Library books are insured in transit and in members' homes, but a proof-of-posting certificate (free at the post office) must be obtained (and retained) before dispatch by post. Recorded delivery or registration is not normally required. If bulky packages are being returned which will not be suitable for my letter box, any advance warning will be appreciated. Since the first Library List was prepared, many years ago, the number of books in the Library has grown enormously, first quadrupling to about 240 in 1982, and then rising by a further 50% by 1990. Since then, the growth has continued steadily. The Library must be, in its subject area, one of the most extensive available to residents of Great Britain.

The List is arranged in three main parts: the first is an alphabetical listing, by Author, of all the books and brochures in the Library. Notwithstanding the long Subject index in the second part of the List, the Author part merits extensive browsing, and your Librarian is confident that most members will find something new to them in this section. The second part, as indicated, is a Subject index, with all the books referred to by their number in the first part. There is a certain amount of deliberate duplication here, wherever this provides the easiest reference to a work: otherwise, books are referred to by the main topics with which they deal. Naturally, very general works, that deal with many different topics, cannot be exhaustively indexed in this way in a listing of this relative brevity - they are generally placed under a subsection 'general', within the main section to which they belong. One space-saving point - all books are presumed to be concerned with stamps, unless the number in the first part is prefaced by a "+", to indicate a postal history work; there are surprisingly few books that deal equally with the stamps **and** postal history of an area!

Finally, there is a third part, dealing with the periodical runs; it is worth repeating that we have a complete run of *Le Monde des Philatélistes*; hence, we possess, in the text of this periodical, all the brochures produced by *Le Monde* from their pages, even though the Library possesses only a limited number of the brochures themselves. Despite rumours to the contrary, there is rarely any change in the contents of the article when it is reprinted as a brochure - that would cost too much!
